# K-12 Education Subtraction and Credit

Minnesota has two programs—the K-12 education subtraction and the K-12 education credit—to help families pay expenses related to their child’s kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade (K-12) education. Both programs lower the tax you must pay and may even provide a larger refund when you file your Minnesota Form M1, *Individual Income Tax Return*.
